

**AN ORDINANCE RELATED TO ESTABLISHING THE HOURS IN WHICH WINE AND MALT BEVERAGES MAY BE SOLD WITHIN THE JURISDICTIONAL BOUNDARIES OF HENRY COUNTY**

WHEREAS, the Henry County Fiscal Court recognizes that it previously adopted an ordinance allowing Sunday sales of wine; and...

WHEREAS, the Henry County Fiscal Court recognizes that the prosperity of business entities in the county is partially dependent upon commerce generated through tourism and travel, some of which occurs on Sundays;

Now therefore be it ORDAINED by the Henry County Fiscal Court as follows:

- 1.) That the hours of operation for the sale of wine and malt beverages at retail by the drink or by the package shall be established as follows:
  - a.) For Monday through Saturday of each week, those hours shall be limited, if at all, only by Kentucky revised statute or regulation of the Department for Alcoholic Beverage Control.
  - b.) For Sunday, said hours shall be from 1:00 p.m. until 10:00 p.m.
- 2.) It is the intention of Henry County Fiscal Court by adoption of this ordinance to exercise the provisions of KRS 244.290(3) and KRS 244.480. Further, and without limitation, this ordinance is intended to authorize sales pursuant hereto in a precinct containing a golf course as provided for in KRS 242.123.
- 3.) Provided, no provision hereof shall be construed to permit the sale of alcohol by any entity or at any location which has not obtained all licenses otherwise required by law.
- 4.) This ordinance shall be constructed in conjunction with Ordinance No. 410-12-10-01 and called An Ordinance Establishing the Hours in Which Wine May Be Sold Within the Jurisdictional Boundaries of Henry County.
